Barry's Christmas Brownies

Since it's the Christmas season, Spire Elland Hospital head chef Barry wanted to share his special recipe for the perfect chocolate brownie.

- Ingredients:**
- Milk chocolate
 - Dark chocolate
 - Granulated sugar
 - Plain white flour
 - Cocoa powder
 - Whipping cream
 - Vanilla Ice-Cream
 - Eggs
 - Butter



Method:

1. Melt the milk chocolate and butter together ensuring it's not too hot
2. Whisk the eggs and sugar for about 15 minutes. When ready, mix in the cooled chocolate and butter. Then add the sieved flour and cocoa powder.
3. Pour in a baking tray and bake at 165c for 40 minutes
4. Melt the dark chocolate with the cream to make the chocolate sauce.
