Information required by referring GP:

In order to prevent cancellations and rejections we will need the following information at point of referral to manage co-morbidities:

- Alcohol and recreational drug use
- Allergies
- Any current investigations patient is undergoing for any other conditions
- Cancer history – treatment and Consultant Oncologist details
- CVA/TIA's and summary cardiac history – stable or unstable
- Diabetes – summary treatment and whether or not stable
- Hypertension – BP readings and whether or not stable

- Patient's height, weight and BMI
- Renal failure

General exclusions:

- Any patient under 18 years of age
- Any patient who requires treatment for suspected cancer
- Patient BMI >40
- Patient with any unstable mental condition and/or is receiving psychiatric treatment
- Revision surgery
- Unstable ASA Grade 3 or greater with some comorbidities

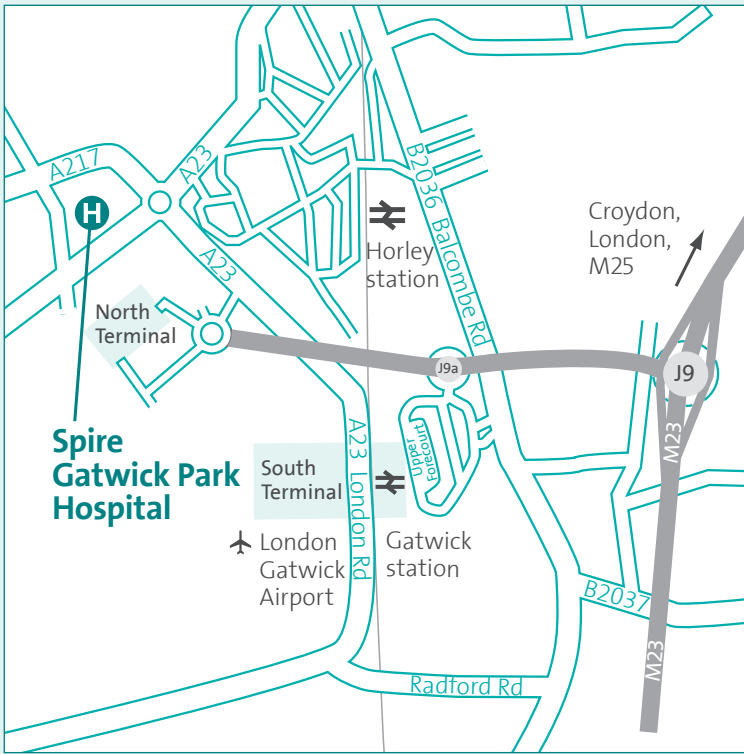
