Breast Care Service Out-patient Charges

When you attend for your out-patient appointment your consultant may require you to have some investigations or treatment.

This price list gives you an indication of the charges for tests and investigations which may be carried out during or after consultation.

If you have any questions about the treatment or investigation your consultant requests, or would like a price confirmed, please ask a member of the out-patient staff before proceeding with treatment.

Insured patients

We advise all insured patients to contact their medical insurance company prior to a consultant appointment to ensure the appropriate level and type of cover is available to them. We will also ask for your credit/debit card details when you arrive at the hospital so that you do not have to worry about paying for any excess or shortfall should one arise.

We will inform you of any shortfall on your account and your card will be charged seven days later.

Self-funding patients

We require payment of all hospital charges on the day of treatment and we ask that you bring a debit or credit card with you. We also collect fees on behalf of many of our consultants. These should be paid on the day of the consultation, however, some consultants may bill you directly for their fees.

It is possible that subsequent investigations may be required; if so we will send you a detailed invoice and seven days later your credit/debit card will be charged.

Out-patient procedures

These are guide prices only and are subject to change. If you would like to confirm a price prior to proceeding with your treatment or investigation, please contact our Self Pay Team.

All of the above will also incur a histology fee.

Your consultant will charge you separately for your consultation and may add an additional fee for any of these procedures. Initial consultation fees range from £130-£200.

Bloods and pathology

A single blood test costs between £40-£250. However your consultant may request several tests.

Prescriptions

Our pharmacist will advise you of the cost of any drugs prescribed by your consultant.

Please note that all out-patient prescriptions are chargeable regardless of any NHS exemptions. Out-patient prescriptions are not covered by private medical insurance.

Guide to consultant charges

Spire Edinburgh Hospitals has introduced a combined billing system for the hospital, consultants and other consultant-initiated diagnostic charges.

If your consultant is using this combined billing system you will receive an invoice from Spire Edinburgh Hospitals only.

If your consultant is not using this combined billing system you will receive an invoice separately from the consultant for consultancy fees and any related consultant diagnostic charges.

Funding your treatment - finance options

Paying for private treatment is simple. If you don't have private medical insurance you can self-fund or take advantage of interest free finance or an interest bearing loan, so you don't have to wait for treatment.
