

Spire Consultant App (SCA) – User Guides

TCI List



TCI is the abbreviation for; **To Come In** and simply means – Arrivals or Admission list. This terminology is widely used in Spire and with other healthcare providers including the NHS.

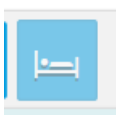
Within this view you can see a list of patients who have arrived *or* are due to arrive for admission today – and as with other views, this will only be for patients you have access to.

Definition of column display:

- **Admission status** – Planned or Actual depending on whether or not the patient has been admitted
- **Patient** – patients name
- **Admission Time** – planned arrival time for the patient’s admission
- **Admitting Consultant** – name of admitting consultant
- **Location** - the hospital where the appointment will take place - this is particularly useful if you’re managing multi-site clinics
- **Scheduled Procedure** – the planned procedure that the patient has been booked in for - please note that this will only appear for patients who are scheduled for surgery.

Alternative admission views:



Clicking on this symbol will change the view so that patients appear in tiles. This view is primarily used to see which bed the patient is in.

Please note that this is not an occupancy view and will only display the bed the patient was booked into on arrival/admission.
