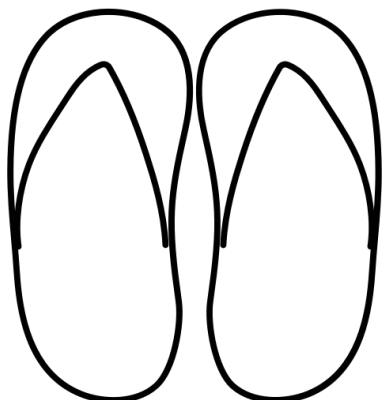
This informal appointment is an opportunity for you to ask any questions you may have about lower limb problems, the routes to diagnosis and the various treatment solutions available.
