

NHS e-Referral at Spire St Anthony's Hospital





Endoscopy clinic	Endoscopic diagnosis and treatment of colorectal symptoms. Lesions of large bowel, diagnosis of rectal bleeding.	Flexible sigmoidoscopy. Diagnostic endoscopic, examination of colon +/- biopsy lesion of colon. Other therapeutic endoscopic operations on colon, intubation of colon. Operation of rectum through anus. Excision of mucosal prolapse. Examination of rectum under general anaesthetic.	Mr Arun Shanmuganandan
Rectal clinic	Anal fissure, anal fistula, haemorrhoids, painful haemorrhoids, perineal absess, perineal warts.	Excision of anal fissure, haemorrhoidectomy, injection of haemorrhoids, lateral sphincterotomy, laying open of low anal fistula, ligation of haemorrhoids, banding of haemorrhoids, excision of anal warts. Nose clinic	Deviated septum / cartilage. Mal-alignment of nasal septum, nasal polyp, nasal blockage. Headaches due to nasal congestion. Recurrent sinus infection. Sinusitis. Restricted nasal air entry.	Drainage of maxilliary antrum. Functional endoscopic sinus surgery (FESS), sinus surgery. Intranasal antrostomy / ethmoidectomy, nasal polypectomy, septoplasty, sub-mucous diathermy. Sub-mucal resention. Turbinectomy. Please note: Not a suitable clinic for second opinions. 

Forefoot only clinic	Forefoot pain. Forefoot joint problems. Morton's metatarsalgia. Hallux Valgus. Hammer toes. Forefoot arthritis including MTPJ.	Correction of bunion / hallux valgus. Transection of peripheral nerve for neuroma. Soft tissue correction of hallux valgus. Fusion of joints of midfoot and forefoot. Excision of ganglion of foot. Excision of heads of multiple lesser metatarsals. Division of bone of foot. Amputation of toes. Multiple metatarsal osteotomies. Primary resurfacing arthroplasty of joint. Excluded procedures: Congenital abnormalities of feet. Correction of congenital deformity of foot. Conversion to prosthetic replacement. Metatarsal phalangeal joint (MTPJ) replacement. Knee clinic	Severe knee pain and disability. Progressive knee deformity / instability. Osteoarthritis of the knee joint. Rheumatoid arthritis of the knee.	Diagnostic / therapeutic arthroscopy of knee joint. Endoscopic excision / resection / repair of semilunar cartilage. Other reconstruction of joint. Removal of internal fixation from bone. Removal of skeletal traction from bone. Total prosthetic replacement of the knee joint. Excluded procedure: ACL is not included. Please refer patients to Knee (ACL) Clinic. Pain management clinic	Neuropathic pain. Back pain. Joint pain. Knee pain. Shoulder pain. Hip pain. Loin pain.	Therapeutic lumbar / sacral epidural injection, facet joint injection, injection of therapeutic substances, nerve root injection, steroid injection. Destructive substance into and around the peripheral nerve. Please note: Not a suitable clinic for second opinions. Prostate (TURP) clinic	Transurethral resection of the prostate	Endoscopic resection of prostate using electrotome, endoscopic resection of prostate using punch, endoscopic resection of prostate, endoscopic sphincterotomy of external sphincter male bladder, endoscopic resection outlet of male bladder. Please note: Patients to have MSU and PSA test results on their referral.	Mr Roger Walker

Information required by referring GP:

In order to prevent cancellations and rejections we will need the following information at point of referral to manage co-morbidities:

- Hypertension BP readings and whether or not it is stable.
- Diabetes summary treatment and whether or not stable.
- Renal failure.
- Allergies.
- Alcohol and recreational drug use.

- Cancer history treatment and Consultant Oncologist details.
- Any current investigations patient is undergoing for any other conditions.
- CVA/TIA's and summary cardiac history stable or unstable.
- Patient's height, weight and BMI.

General Exclusions

- Patient BMI >40.
- Any patient under 18yrs of age.
- Any patient who requires treatment for suspected cancer.
- Revision surgery.

- Patient with unstable mental condition and is receiving psychiatric treatment.
- Unstable ASA Grade 3 or greater with some comorbidities.
