

Corporate Hospitality events for referring clinicians

Corporate hospitality events held by the hospital at no charge to referring clinicians are set out below for 2015-2019, together with the cost of providing such events:

- December 2019: Spire Edinburgh Hospitals' Christmas Dance took place on 7 December. All staff and consultants are invited with partners. Fifty-four consultants attended with 25 bringing a partner. The average cost per head was £100
- September 2019: Spire Edinburgh Hospitals' Medical Advisory Committee (MAC) annual general meeting took place. All consultants on our medical society are invited to attend along with their partners. Over 70 attended with the average cost of £65 a head
- August 2019: All Consultants were invited to attend the opening event of the 2019 Edinburgh Fringe Society Festival. Twenty-four consultants plus partners attended and the total cost per head was approximately £67
- July 2019: The Medical Advisory Committee (MAC) Chair and MAC Clinical Governance Lead were invited together with their partners to Wimbledon. The average cost per person was £1,225
- June 2019: Consultants were invited to attend the Royal Highland Show. Four consultants and partners attend. There was no cost as tickets were given to Spire Edinburgh Hospitals as part of a sponsorship arrangement
- March 2019: Spire Edinburgh Hospitals' Medical Advisory Committee (MAC) is made up of a group of Consultants who meet quarterly and whose job is to advise the Hospital Director and Matron on medical matters and who provide expertise and oversight of the hospital's clinical governance. This is an unpaid role and as a thank you to a retiring member of the MAC the Hospital Director took the Consultant and partner to dinner and a theatre show. The average cost per head was £80
- February 2019: 19 consultants were taken to a Six Nations match on Saturday 9 February at a cost of £13 per head for hospitality plus tickets. Tickets were no cost to Spire as they are part of sponsorship deal, but valued at approx £100 each
- December 2018: 13 consultants and their families attended the 1872 Edinburgh v Glasgow rugby match. There was no cost as these tickets are part of our Scottish Rugby sponsorship
- December 2018: Spire Edinburgh Hospitals' Christmas Dance took place on 8 December. All staff and Consultants are invited with partners. Thirty-nine consultants attended with 13 bringing a partner. The average cost per head was £55



- November 2018: Consultants were invited to the Scotland v South Africa Autumn test. 25 consultants and partners attended at an approximate cost of £40 a head
- November 2018: Consultants were invited to attend Scottish Love in Action fireworks displays. Twenty consultants and their families attended. There was no cost as tickets were given to Spire Edinburgh Hospitals as part of a sponsorship arrangement
- September 2018: Spire Edinburgh Hospitals' Medical Advisory Committee (MAC) Annual general meeting took place. All consultants on our medical society are invited to attend along with their partners. Over 80 attended with the average cost of £68 a head
- August 2018: All Consultants were invited to attend the opening event of the 2018 Edinburgh Fringe Society Festival. Thirty-four consultants and partners attended and the total cost per head was approximately £43
- June 2018: Consultants were invited to attend the Royal Highland Show. Eight consultants and partners attend. There was no cost as tickets were given to Spire Edinburgh Hospitals as part of a sponsorship arrangement
- February 2018: Consultants were invited to attend Scotland v England six nations. Twenty-five consultants and partners attended. The total cost per head was approximately £80

- January 2017: Spire Edinburgh Hospitals' Christmas Dance took place on 21 January. All staff and Consultants are invited. The average cost per head was £65
- August 2016: Spire Edinburgh Hospitals' Medical Advisory Committee (MAC) is made up of a group of Consultants who meet quarterly and whose job is to advise the Hospital Director and Matron on medical matters and who provide expertise and oversight of the hospital's clinical governance. This is an unpaid role and as a thank you the Hospital Director takes the Committee and their partners for dinner each year. The average cost per head for the 2016 dinner was £148
