# How to refer

#### Information required by referring GP:

In order to prevent cancellations and rejections we will need the following information at point of referral to manage co-morbidities:

- Hypertension BP readings and whether or not it is stable
- Diabetes summary treatment and whether or not stable
- Renal failure
- Allergies
- Alcohol and recreational drug use
- Cancer history treatment and Consultant Oncologist details
- Any current investigations patient is undergoing for any other conditions
- CVA/TIA's and summary cardiac history stable or unstable
- Patient's height, weight and BMI

#### **General exclusions**

- Patient BMI >40
- Any patient under 18 years of age
- Any patient who requires treatment for suspected cancer
- Revision surgery
- Patient with unstable mental condition and is receiving psychiatric treatment
- Unstable ASA Grade 3 or greater with some comorbidities
