Spire Nottingham Hospital has a dedicated Cardiology and Cardiac service, for all your heart's needs. We offer a range of tests, scans and procedures performed by consultant cardiologists, cardiac physiologists, cardiac nurses and cardiac surgeons for adults and under 18's.

Our experienced staff will ensure your visit to us is as convenient and comfortable as possible. We will provide advice, guidance and support at every stage and will explain what tests we are going to do, how long they will take, what you can expect and the costs.

Anaphylaxis, angioedema, latex allergy and mast cell activation syndromes, management of food hypersensitivity (including food anaphylaxis, IgE and non-IgE-mediated food allergy and food intolerance), seasonal and perennial allergic rhinitis and urticarial conditions.

Sees adults and children. Balance disorders, general ENT, otology and paediatric ENT.

Professor Douglas Hartley

Sees adults and children. Balance problems and dizziness, bone-anchored hearing aids and cochlear implants, chronic ear disease and cholesteatoma, ear surgery including grommets, hearing loss, mastoidectomy, nose and sinus problems, ear, nose and throat conditions in adults and children, tonsil and adenoid problems.
