Spire Shawfair Park Hospital's rapid access fracture clinic is designed to support patients who have been to their GP or local minor injuries unit and require orthopaedic treatment or surgical follow up.

Initial Consultant appointment within
72 hours at Spire Shawfair Park Hospital



Imaging, casting and splinting as required



Onward referral to physiotherapists
or surgery within 10 days

Benefits of the rapid access fracture clinic

- Outpatient appointment within 72 hours of phone call
- Consultant led care by trauma and orthopaedic specialists
- Same day consultation, x-ray and, if required, pre op surgical intervention
- Choice of surgical date
- Where clinically indicated, surgery can be scheduled within 10 days of initial injury
- Onsite plastering or splinting as required at the initial outpatient clinic
- Excellent private hospital facilities with a reputation for exceptional MSK and orthopaedic care
