If you have advised your patient to contact us directly for an appointment, your referral letter should be sent to us within three working days so we can offer your patient the soonest available appointment.

SCI Gateway

All our specialties, and sub specialties where relevant, are visible under Murrayfield and Shawfair Park drop-downs. If you are a GP from a health board outwith Lothian, you can refer your patients to us the following way:

- Click on the new message option and change the health board from your local health board to Lothian
- From the drop down menu, select Murrayfield or Shawfair Park Hospital
- Choose the specialty that you are looking for

Once we receive the (SCI Gateway) referral we will contact your patient by telephone to arrange a suitable appointment.

Self-funding patients

GP referrals are not always necessary for patients who choose to self-fund. However, the consultant may request additional information from your practice following initial consultation. Please be advised that some of our consultants do require a referral letter.

Patients with private medical insurance

A referral letter is generally required before any insured patient can be seen by a consultant. Patients can call our outpatient appointment team on **0131 316 2530** to arrange a convenient appointment. We will require the patient's policy details at the time of booking. It is important that your patient contacts their insurer to obtain authorisation.

Clinics and services

Children and Young People's Service

Spire Edinburgh Hospitals' children and young people's service is available across a number of specialities. (See page 16 for our paediatric consultants.)

At Murrayfield we see patients aged 0 – 16 for outpatient consultations (non-interventional only).
At Shawfair we see patients aged 0 – 16 years old for outpatient consultations.

Paediatric procedures will be carried out as a daycase at Shawfair for patients aged 3 – 16.

We offer treatments across a wide range of childhood illnesses and diseases including:

- Allergy clinic
- Dental
- Ear, nose and throat (ENT) such as grommets, adenoids and tongue ties and more, but we currently do not have the facilities to treat tonsillectomy patients
- Eye treatment and surgery including squint repairs and more
- Gastroenterology
- General surgery including hernia repairs
- Orthopaedics including ACL reconstructions and meniscal repairs and more
- Plastics consultations and procedures including birthmarks, excision of lesions or ear pinnaplasties
- Radiology
- Urology problems and treatments including orchidopexies and circumcisions

We have a range of specialists who can see children and young people at either Murrayfield or Shawfair Park as an outpatient. All day case procedures are carried out at Shawfair.

Diagnostic imaging

Imaging services are available at both Spire Murrayfield and Shawfair Park Hospitals and cover a wide range of both diagnostic and therapeutic interventions.

The department undertakes general X-Ray plus Cardiac, CT (inc biopsy and virtual colonography), MRI Mammography and Ultrasound.

Images and radiology reports are electronically stored to the hospital's Picture Archiving Communication System (PACS). The voice activated reporting system allows a fast turnaround of results.

All imaging procedures are performed by registered radiographers or consultant radiologists.

We aim to provide a rapid access service for many examinations across our sites and can often offer same day appointments.

All referrals for imaging in either Murrayfield or Shawfair Park should be requested via SCI Gateway.

Our imaging facilities at Murrayfield include:

- CT
- Digital mammography (including a one stop clinic)
- Fluoroscopy including HSG, arthrography, urology and barium studies
- MRI including prostate, cardiac, breast, arthrography and angiography
- Plain film imaging
- Ultrasound including gynaecological, guided biopsy, FNA and therapeutic injections

Our imaging facilities at Shawfair include:

- Cardiac cath lab
- Fluoroscopy including HSG, arthrography, urology and barium studies
- Mobile MRI
- Plain film imaging
- Ultrasound including US guided biopsy, FNA and therapeutic injections

Allergy

Prof E J Cameron

Acute allergy (hay fever, food allergy) angio-oedema, immune function. Breathlessness, chronic cough, difficult asthma, pulmonary fibrosis, COPD, emphysema, bronchiectasis, lung cancer, sleep apnoea screening. Unexplained weight loss. Occupational respiratory assessments.

Dr D Hodge

Paediatric allergist with expertise in the management of children's allergy, including food allergy, eczema, asthma, hay fever, reflux and colic.

Audiology

Mr J Allen

Audiologist and hearing aid dispenser. Paediatric and adult diagnostic audiology, a full rehabilitative service including assessment, fitting and purchase of digital hearing aids, tinnitus and hyperacusis management, supply and fitting of all customised ear plugs.

Breast surgery

Mr C Cartlidge

Breast cancer and oncoplastic reconstruction. Benign breast disease including pain, nipple discharge and lumps. Family history patients, second opinions and complex revisional surgery including fat transfer following previous cancer treatment.

Mr K Elder

Management of all benign breast diseases. Management of Breast cancer including oncoplastic and reconstructive surgery. Management of patients with family history of breast disease. Management of breast pain.

All general cardiology referrals including those related to coronary artery disease, echocardiography, hypertension, stroke prevention, vascular medicine, valvular heart disease, MI prevention, aortic stenosis, pacemakers, defibrillators, cardiac resynchronisation therapy, cardiac CT and MRI.

Arrhythmia, pacemaker, ablation, atrial fibrillation, defibrillator, ICD, syncope, SVT, tachycardia, pacemaker, collapse, cardiac resynchronisation, rhythm problems.

Minimally invasive colorectal surgery for cancer, inflammatory bowel and benign disease.

Rectal bleeding, incontinence, prolapse, colonoscopy, benign and malignant colorectal disease.

Mr Gregory E Ekatah

Colonoscopy; colon and rectal surgery (robotic, laparoscopic and open), hernia repair (robotic and open), anal fissures and fistulas and skin lumps and bumps.

Continence

Mr A Alhasso

Reconstructive and functional urology: urethral stricture disease, male urinary incontinence (artificial urinary sphincter and male sling surgery), female urinary incontinence (urethral slings, tapes, bulking agent injections and colposuspension). Bladder dysfunction (idiopathic and neuropathic overactive bladder dysfunction) – botulinum toxin injection and neuromodulation (SNS and PTNS). Urinary diversion surgery, functional bladder studies – Video-Urodynamics (Videocystometry). General urology: Peno-scrotal surgery (circumcision, hydrocele repair, epididymal cyst excision, prosthetic testicular implantation). Prostatic disease (prostate surgery and GreenLight laser prostatectomy). Aquablation treatment for prostatic enlargement. Optilume, a specialised treatment for urethral stricture disease.

Miss P V Granitsiotis

Female urology, stress urinary incontinence, overactive bladder syndrome/incontinence, recurrent urinary tract infections, female urinary retention, bladder pain/Interstitial cystitis, bladder problems in neuropathic patient (spinal problems, MS etc), urodynamics. General urology including haematuria and benign prostate problems.

Mr K Janjua

Female urology – stress urinary incontinence, overactive bladder including bladder botulinum toxin injections. Recurrent urinary tract infections. Haematuria. Benign prostatic disease, including green-light laser prostatectomy. Daycase surgery including circumcision, hydrocele repair, epididymal cyst excision.

Dr S C Nicholson

Urogynaecology. Surgery for prolapse and urinary incontinence. Urodynamics. Menstrual problems and pelvic pain. Laparoscopic surgery including laparoscopic hysterectomy and laparoscopic removal of ovarian cysts. Colposcopy.

D

Dermatology

Dr M Farrugia

General adult dermatology (including acne, eczema and psoriasis). Skin cancer screening and mole checks. Skin surgery including skin cancer, mole, skin tag, and lipoma removal. Paediatric and adolescent dermatology.

Dr S Fraser

General dermatology, skin cancer, minor skin surgery, assessment of moles and other skin lesions (including skin tags). Does not see children and generally does not see acne patients under 18 years of age.

Dr S A Holme

General dermatology, acne, dermatitis, psoriasis, hyperhidrosis, moles, skin cancer and skin cancer surgery.

Dr S McCormack

General dermatology, acne, psoriasis, dermatitis, moles, skin cancers, vulval dermatology.

Dr M Mowbray

General dermatology, hair disease (alopecia and hirsutism), nail disease, moles, skin cancer and skin cancer surgery. Does not see children and does not see acne patients under 18 years of age.

Dr A S M Tidman

General medical dermatology, skin cancer.

Dr M J Tidman

Medical dermatology, dermatological oncology, paediatric and adolescent dermatology, general dermatology.

Dietitian

Ms V Giudice

Bariatric surgery.

Miss C McAnenny

Clinical nutrition, including management of obesity diabetes, IBS, coeliac disease and any gastrointestinal disorders resulting in nutritional issues. All aspects of liver nutrition including metabolic syndrome and the management of patients with fatty liver or liver cirrhosis. Also the therapeutic management of patients that are malnourished and have a MUST score of two or above.

Dr F Pender

Clinical nutrition, including management of overweight and obesity, diabetes and the metabolic syndrome, underweight and pre-surgical patients, all aspects of renal nutrition. Eating disorders, cancer, allergy and specialist therapeutic interventions, together with dietary analysis form a routine caseload.

Endocrinology and diabetes mellitus, parathyroid disease, pituitary disease and thyroid disease, hormone imbalance (male and female), menopause management, medical weight loss. Effective use of lifestyle medicine for long term benefit in chronic conditions and weight management (BSLM certified expert).

Dr M Lyall

Diabetes, thyroid disorders, thyroid nodular, thyroid cancer, Addisons disease, calcium and pituitary disorder.

ENT

Mr R Adamson

Edinburgh Teaching Hospital Consultant with special interest in voice, airway, swallowing, thyroid disorders including cancers and neck/salivary lumps. The only subspecialist laryngologist working in the private sector in Edinburgh.

Mr P Asimakopoulos

Head and neck cancer, neck lumps, thyroid and parathyroid disease, disorders of swallowing and speech, general ENT disorders and ear wax removal.

Mr D Baring

Tertiary teaching hospital practice working in the Edinburgh ENT group specialising in ear surgery, balance and paediatrics as well as a general ENT practice in rhinology and head and neck work, ear wax removal.

Mr A M D Bennett

Adult and paediatric otolaryngology including nasal blockage, allergic rhinitis, sinusitis, ear infections, glue ear, cholesteatoma, hearing loss, tinnitus and vertigo.

Assessment of throat, neck, voice and swallowing disorders. Expert assessment of neck lumps.

Gastroenterology

Interests include altered bowel habit, rectal bleeding, inflammatory bowel disease, irritable bowel syndrome, iron deficiency anaemia, upper endoscopy (including trans-nasal endoscopy), colonoscopy, capsule endoscopy, gastro-oesophageal reflux, food intolerance, bacterial overgrowth, small bowel disease.

Refractory acid reflux, LPR, swallowing difficulty, nausea, dyspepsia, constipation and evacuatory problems, diarrhoea, IBS, bloating, food intolerance and bacterial overgrowth, breath testing, anaemia, rectal bleeding, bowel cancer screening, removal of bowel polyps, small bowel diseases, endoscopy (gastroscopy, TNE, colonoscopy, capsule endoscopy, Stretta procedure, DBE).

Inflammatory bowel disease (Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis), diarrhoea and weight loss, iron deficiency anaemia, diagnostic endoscopy and colonoscopy.

Dr A McGowan

Abdominal pain, bowel disease, iron deficiency anaemia, reflux, endoscopy, colonoscopy, pancreas and bile duct disorders.

Similarly, when a patient presents with features of spinal stenosis, a clear diagnosis is very helpful when other conditions mimic it, such as vascular disease, facet joint arthritis, and gluteal tendinopathy. Similarly, when a patient presents with features of spinal stenosis, a clear diagnosis is very helpful when other conditions mimic it, such as vascular disease, facet joint arthritis, and gluteal tendinopathy. Retired from the NHS after forty years but continue to operate for these straightforward spinal conditions.

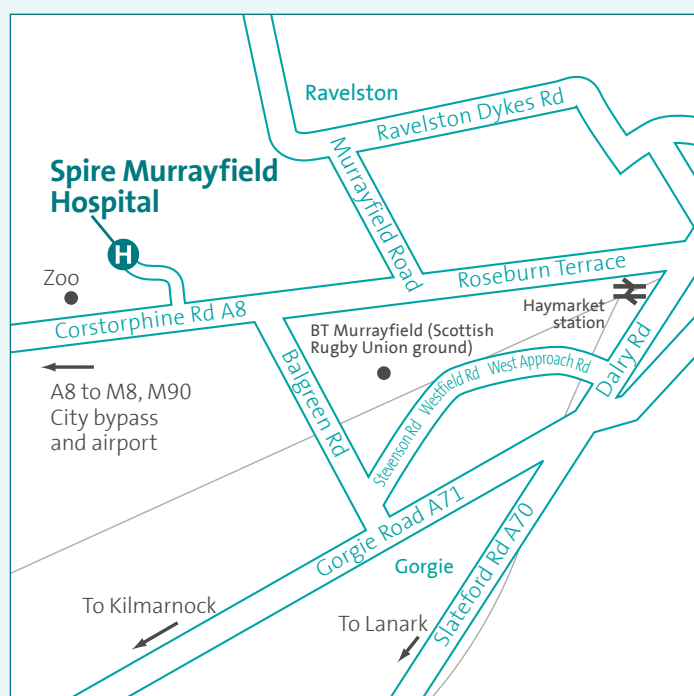
