## Primary healthcare online referral guide

Spire Connect enables practice staff to log in and send secure, instant online referrals to Spire Healthcare hospitals for self-funding and PMI patients. The system is designed to be as simple and efficient as possible, while protecting all confidential information within secure servers. It's our people that really set us apart.

### GP registration

When you access Spire Connect for the first time you will be required to register a few personal details to allow you access to the site and grant you permission to make referrals.

### Making a referral

To make a referral click on the 'Make an online referral' link and complete all relevant details. The referrals for each patient will need to come from the GP making the referral.

### Imaging and other referral types

You can make referrals for radiological investigations by selecting 'Radiology' under the specialty list. To make a referral for physiotherapy, podiatry, dietetics, psychology etc, select one of these from under 'Allied Health Professionals' in the specialty list.

### Attaching patient notes

It is possible to attach patient notes to the form, however the ease of this will depend on your own patient record software. Take a look at the options available in your software to see if records can be 'exported' or 'saved as' to your desktop. Then from there you can attach them to this form. You will need to save the notes in a common format such as a text or word document (.rtf, .pdf, .doc, .txt), a spreadsheet (.xls or .csv) or an image format (eg .bmp, .jpg). Then click the 'send referral' button at the bottom of the page to submit the referral.

### Allergy

#### Dr Alexandra Croom

Anaphylaxis, angioedema, latex allergy, mast cell activation syndrome, IgE-mediated food allergy, seasonal and perennial allergic rhinitis and urticarial conditions.

## B

### Breast surgery

#### Mr Amit Goyal

Breast cancer surgery, breast enlargement (augmentation), breast lift (mastopexy), breast reconstruction, breast reduction, breast reduction for men (gynaecomastia), liposuction, nipple correction and scar revision.

#### Miss Monika Kaushik

Benign breast problems, breast cancer and oncoplastic surgery, breast lump investigation, cosmetic breast surgery, breast reconstruction and revision surgery, male breast symptoms and axillary conditions.

#### Mr Jaroslaw Krupa

## Cardiac surgery

### Mr Giovanni Mariscalco

Coronary artery bypass surgery, aortic valve repair/replacement and mitral valve repair/replacement, aortic root repair/replacement and complex aortic surgery through conventional approaches and mini-invasive (key hole surgery).

### Mr Shantanu Sinha

Mitral valve repair surgery, tricuspid valve repair surgery, endoscopic mitral valve surgery, AF ablation surgery, coronary artery bypass grafting and aortic valve replacement.

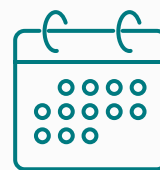

## Cardiology

Specialises in a full range of rheumatological conditions including inflammatory arthritis (rheumatoid, psoriasis, reactive and enteropathic) systemic lupus erythematosus, connective tissue disease (myositis, sjogrens syndrome, scleroderma, vasculitis), hypermobility, lower back pain, sciatica, neck, shoulder, wrist pain, crystal arthritis (gout, calcium pyrophosphate), osteoporosis, fibromyalgia, soft tissue rheumatology, aspiration and injections of joints and bursa.

## Sport and exercise medicine

### Dr Patrick O'Halloran

Sees children from 12 years. Carpal tunnel joint pain treatment (joint injections) pain management, platelet rich plasma therapy (PRP), and sportsman's hernia or groin treatment.

### Professor Nicholas Peirce

Sees children from 16 years. Diagnosis, and treatment of musculoskeletal and sports injuries/illness related to physical activity, sport and workplace. Management of joint, tendon, muscle, ligament and nerve pain including early osteoarthritis relating to neck, shoulder, arm, elbow, forearm, wrist, chest wall abdominal wall, back, buttock, hip, groin, thigh, knee, patella, lower leg, calf ankle, heel, foot, rotator cuff, subacromial, tennis/golfers elbow, meniscus, achilles tendon, sports hernia, quadriceps and hamstring. In clinic ultrasound assessment, injections, PRP, hyaluronic acid and MDT approach to return to activity including sport and workplace. Using exercise as a treatment for and prevention of health conditions.

## Urology

### Mr Bharat More

Sees children from birth. All urological and general surgical procedures in children, circumcision, cystoscopy, hernia surgery, hypospadias repair, laparoscopy, undescended testis and urinary incontinence.
