## Primary healthcare online referral guide

Spire Connect enables practice staff to log in and send secure, instant online referrals to Spire Healthcare hospitals for self-funding and PMI patients. The system is designed to be as simple and efficient as possible, while protecting all confidential information within secure servers.

### GP registration

When you access Spire Connect for the first time you will be required to register a few personal details to allow you access to the site and grant you permission to make referrals.

### Making a referral

To make a referral click on the 'Make an online referral' link and complete all relevant details. The referrals for each patient will need to come from the GP making the referral.

### Imaging and other referral types

You can make referrals for radiological investigations by selecting 'Radiology' under the specialty list. To make a referral for physiotherapy, podiatry, dietetics, psychology etc, select one of these from under 'Allied Health Professionals' in the specialty list.

### Attaching patient notes

It is possible to attach patient notes to the form, however the ease of this will depend on your own patient record software. Take a look at the options available in your software to see if records can be 'exported' or 'saved as' to your desktop. Then from there you can attach them to this form. You will need to save the notes in a common format such as a text or word document (.rtf, .pdf, .doc, .txt), a spreadsheet (.xls or .csv) or an image format (eg .bmp, .jpg). Then click the 'send referral' button at the bottom of the page to submit the referral.

## A

### Allied Health Professionals

#### Miss Krupa Goyal

Sees adults and children. Audiology testing only.

#### Ms Sonal Patel

Sees adults and children. Nutritional support following illness for cancer/oncology, gastrointestinal (irritable bowel syndrome (use of low FODMAP diet), coeliac, food intolerances, weight management, diabetes, cardiovascular health (high blood pressure, high cholesterol) balanced eating, paediatric dietetics (fussy eating), obesity and healthy eating.

#### Mr Matthew Pilley

Sees adults and children. Adult micropigmentation and paediatric facial prosthetics.

## B

### Breast and oncoplastic surgery

#### Miss Monika Kaushik

Benign breast problems, breast cancer and oncoplastic surgery, breast lump investigation, cosmetic breast surgery, breast reconstruction and revision surgery, male breast symptoms and axillary conditions.

#### Mr Jaroslaw Krupa

Benign breast problems, investigations of breast symptoms, breast cancer and oncoplastic surgery, mastectomy, breast reconstruction, breast reduction, breast augmentation, breast lift (mastopexy) and cosmetic breast surgery, implants exchange/removal, revisional implant surgery, prophylactic mastectomy.

#### Mr Simon Pilgrim

Breast and oncoplastic, breast cancer, benign breast problems and one-stop breast clinic. Cosmetic breast surgery: breast reduction, breast augmentation and mastopexy (breast lift).

#### Mr Walid Sasi

Breast cancer and oncoplastic surgery, mastectomy, total and partial breast reconstruction, breast reduction, breast augmentation, breast lift (mastopexy), breast lipomodelling and cosmetic breast surgery, male breast surgery.

## C

### Cardiology

#### Dr Imran Ansari

All aspects of adult cardiology. Multi-modality cardiac imaging (stress cardiac MRI, cardiac CT, stress echocardiography and advanced 3D echocardiography). Early cardiac risk assessment, investigation and management of chest pain, palpitations, valvular heart disease, breathlessness, blackout and heart failure.

#### Dr Rajesh Chelliah

Heart failure, implantable devices, device therapy, arrhythmias, pacing (cardiology), hypertension, lipid management, weight management, invasive cardiology and cardiac electrophysiology.

#### Dr Shazia Hussain

General cardiology, coronary artery disease, coronary angiography and angioplasty, chest pain assessment, blood-pressure assessment and control, management of valvular disease, investigation of palpitations and interpretation of ECG's and monitoring and women's cardiovascular health.

#### Dr Jeffrey Khoo

General cardiology (including ECG, rhythm monitoring/Holter, exercise test, CAA cardiology reviews), and advanced cardiac imaging (including echo, TOE, stress echo and cardiac MRI).

#### Professor Jan Kovak

Cardiac catheterisation, radial and femoral coronary angioplasty, stenting, mitral valvuloplasty, LAA closure, PFO closure, septal defect closures, TAVI and balloon aortic valvuloplasty, TEER (transcatheter repair of mitral and tricuspid valves, valve in valve procedures).

#### Dr Bhavik Modi

All aspects of adult cardiology, including cardiac risk factor modification, high blood pressure, high cholesterol, chest pain, blackouts, palpitations, atrial fibrillation, valvular heart disease, shortness of breath and post heart attack care. Investigation and management of chest pain, breathlessness, angina and heart attacks, including angiography, cardiac catheterisation, angioplasty and stenting.

#### Professor Ghulam Ng

Specialises in arrhythmia management (SVT, atrial fibrillation, ectopics) especially investigations of palpitation, syncope and blackouts, providing cardiac electrophysiology treatment including cardioversion and catheter ablation. Provides investigations and management of other areas of cardiology e.g. sudden death risk assessment and inherited cardiac conditions.

#### Dr Ravi Pathmanathan

General cardiology, arrhythmia and management of ischaemic heart disease.

#### Professor Sir Nilesh Samani

All aspects of cardiology in adults including high blood pressure (hypertension), coronary artery disease, angina, heart attacks, heart failure heart arrhythmias, heart valve disease, cardiomyopathy, family history and prevention of heart disease. Symptoms including: chest pain, palpitations, blackout, heart flutter, shortness of breath, breathlessness, syncope, heart murmurs, irregular heart beat, high blood pressure and swollen legs.

#### Dr Alistair Sandilands

General cardiology, electrophysiology, atrial fibrillation and cardioversion, palpitations, arrhythmias, sudden cardiac death and cardiovascular genetics, syncope and blackouts.

#### Dr Riyaz Somani

Sees adults and children. Investigations and management of all areas of cardiology including palpitations, chest pain, blackouts and hypertension. Specialises in arrhythmias such as atrial fibrillation, SVT, atrial flutter providing cardiac imaging, cardioversion, catheter ablation and pacemaker/ defibrillator insertion as well as caring for patients with cardiomyopathies and inherited cardiac conditions.

## Cosmetic and plastic surgery

### Mr Anil Banerjee

Sees adults and children. Cosmetic rhinoplasty and pinnaplasty (prominent ears).

Breast enlargement, breast reduction, breast uplift and revision surgery, male breast reduction, body lifts, prominent ear correction, fat grafting (lipofilling), facial, abdominoplasty, liposuction, rhinoplasty and blepharoplasty.

## Dermatology

Acne treatment, actinic keratosis, cryotherapy treatment, eczema treatment, hyperhidrosis (excessive sweating), psoriasis, skin cancer (melanoma, basal cell carcinoma, squamous cell carcinoma) diagnosis and treatment, skin lesion removal surgery, cysts, warts and skin tag removal.

### Dr Karen Harman

Blistering disorders, vulval dermatoses, skin cancer and inflammatory skin disease.

### Dr Graham Johnston

Sees adults and children. Contact dermatitis, patch testing, dermatology, allergy, dermatological surgery, inflammatory skin disease including eczema, psoriasis and acne, moles, skin cancer and cosmetic reactions.

### Dr James Miller

Sees adults and children. Eczema and dermatitis, mole, cyst, wart and skin tag removal, psoriasis treatment, acne and treatment of malignant skin cancer.

### Dr Manisha Panchal

Treatment for malignant skin cancer, cryotherapy, curettage and cautery of lesion, excision of lesion from head, neck, limbs and trunk inflammatory skin disease. Psoriasis, eczema, acne, rosacea, hidradenitis suppurativa, hair and nail disorder, punch biopsy of lesion or rash, shave excision, skin cancer and skin surgery.

### Dr Akhtar Rasool

Longterm skin conditions including acne, psoriasis, eczema, rosacea, alopecia, vitiligo, urticaria and other forms of skin inflammatory conditions. skin cancers and skin cancer surgery, benign skin lumps and bumps, diagnosis and surgical removal.

### Dr Matthew Scorer

Acne, rosacea, eczema, psoriasis, skin cancer diagnosis and surveillance, sun damage, hair and scalp disorders, inflammatory skin conditions, cutaneous lymphoma, mole checks, dermoscopy, cryotherapy, curettage and cautery, skin biopsies, excision of skin lesions and intralesional corticosteroid injections.

## Dietician

### Ms Sonal Patel

Sees adults and children. Regain weight following a spell of ill-health or as the result of a medical condition, are wanting or needing to lose weight, bariatric surgery patient, food allergy and intolerance, digestive problems e.g. IBS or Coeliac disease, diagnosed with a medical condition such as diabetes, high blood pressure, raised blood lipids or cardiovascular disease.

## Ear, nose and throat

### Mr Anil Banerjee

Sees adults and children. Cosmetic rhinoplasty, functional rhinoplasty, otology, balance disorders, nasal obstruction, sinus disease, treatment of snoring, ear disease, nasal allergy, sleep apnoea, Bell's palsy and cholesteatoma.

### Mr Peter Conboy

Sees adults and children. Head and neck cancers, salivary gland disease, thyroid disease, treatment of snoring, rhinology, treatment of childrens ENT diseases, laryngology, throat biopsy, biopsy of voice box and branchial cyst removal.

### Professor Peter Rea

Sees adults and children. Vertigo and balance disorders, middle ear reconstruction, hearing loss, tinnitus, sinus disease including allergy, snoring, otology, ear infection, vertigo, rhinology, nasal obstruction, cholesteatoma and Epley manoeuvre.

### Professor Bindy Sahota

Sees adults and children. Head and neck cancers, salivary gland disease, thyroid disease, treatment of snoring, rhinology, treatment of childrens ENT diseases, laryngology, throat biopsy, biopsy of voice box and branchial cyst removal.



### Mr Javed Uddin

Sees adults and children. Ear problems, ear infections, hearing loss, tinnitus, dizziness/vertigo, nasal blockage, nasal polyps, sinusitis, sinus surgery, nasal allergy, nosebleeds, treatment of snoring, tonsil and throat problems, thyroid and neck lumps, voice problems and throat biopsies.

### Mr Theodoros Valsamakis

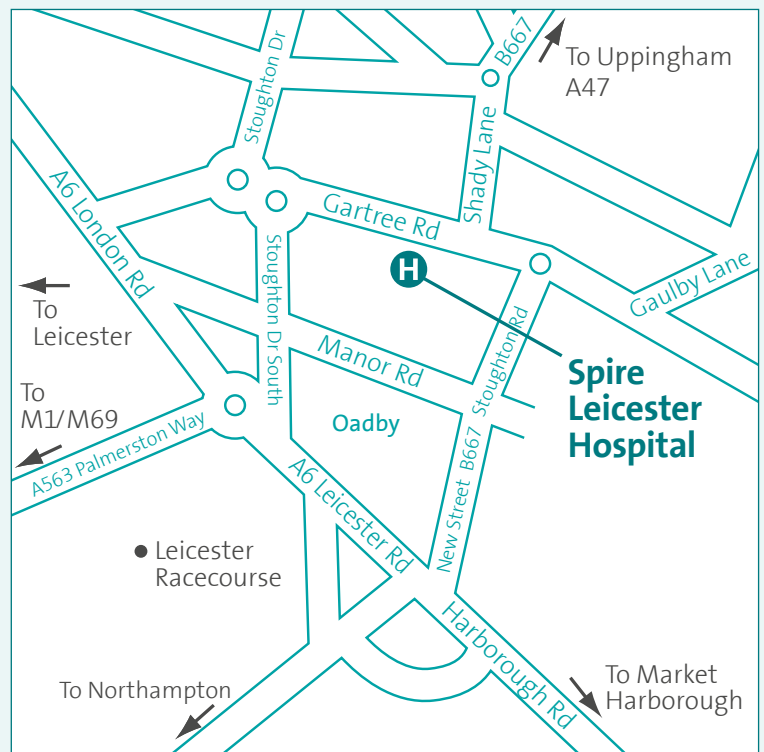
