GP registration

When you access Spire Connect for the first time you will be required to register a few personal details to allow you access to the site and grant you permission to make referrals.

Making a referral

To make a referral click on the 'Make an online referral' link and complete all relevant details. The referrals for each patient will need to come from the GP making the referral.

NHS referrals

Imaging and other referral types

You can make referrals for radiological investigations by selecting 'Radiology' under the specialty list. To make a referral for physiotherapy or pathology, select either of these from under 'Allied Health Professionals' in the specialty list.

Attaching patient notes

It is possible to attach patient notes to the form, however the ease of this will depend on your own patient record software. Take a look at the options available in your software to see if records can be 'exported' or 'saved as' to your desktop. Then from there you can attach them to this form. You will need to save the notes in a common format such as a text or word document (.rtf, .pdf, .doc, .txt), a spreadsheet (.xls or .csv) or an image format (eg .bmp, .jpg). Then click the 'send referral' button at the bottom of the page to submit the referral.

Clinics and services

Cardiology

Spire St Anthony's Hospital provides a full range of treatments for heart conditions, including diagnostic investigations and interventional cardiac procedures.

Non-invasive cardiology services include:

- Ambulatory heart rate monitoring – Halter and Zio patch (24 hour, 48 hour, 72 hour, 1 week, 2 week)
- Ambulatory blood pressure monitoring
- Cardiac MRI
- Direct current (DC) cardioversions
- Exercise tolerance testing
- Implantable device checks (internal loop recorders, pacemakers, defibrillators and biventricular devices – both in clinic and remotely)
- Transthoracic echo, stress echo, contrast echo, bubble echo, CRT optimisation

Invasive cardiology services include:

- Angioplasties (including fractional flow reserve, intravascular ultrasound and rotablation)
- Diagnostic angiograms
- Electrophysiology (diagnostic and ablation procedures using RF ablation, cryotherapy, Pulse Field Ablation and 3D mapping)
- Implantable devices (internal loop recorders, pacemakers, defibrillators, and biventricular devices)
- Intra-aortic balloon pump insertion
- Right heart catheterisation
- TAVI (Transcatheter Aortic Valve Implantation)
- Temporary pacing wire insertion
- TOE (Transoesophageal Echocardiogram) with 3D imaging
